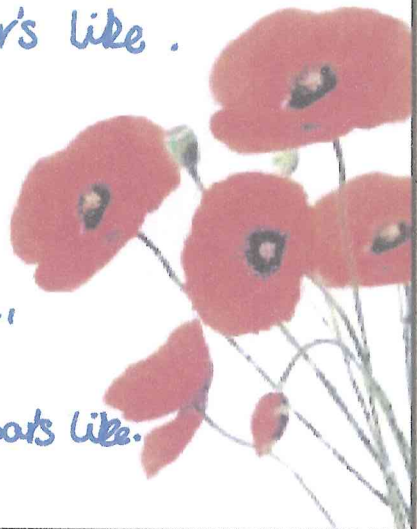


You don't know
