



P.S.H.E.

English

Reading comp - Traditional Tales with a modern twist

Writing - description of characters, settings and story writing. Newspaper reports (linked with history/geography) (other genres as the unit develops)

SPAG - skills taught linked to the unit.

Suggested Texts

- Fairy-tale News, Three bad pigs, Pretty Salma, Into the forest, Hoodwinked.

DT

Design and make purposeful, functional and appealing products. Select and name the tools needed to work the materials. scissors, saws, drills. Use a range of materials to create models with wheels, axels or hinges. Investigate temporary, fixed and moving joints.

Activities - *make a fairaround ride*

Maths

- Symmetrical flag design
- Measuring how tall plants are and the circumference of trees in the nature area.

Computing

- Use different font sizes, colours and images to communicate meaning for a given audience.
- Use presentation software.
- Save digital content to cloud based storage system.
- Understand that programmes are a sequence of simple instructions.
- Create and test a simple programme.
- Use a programme to control a physical hardware.

Activities - *PowerPoint presentation of our own fairy-tale, about Christopher Columbus. Bee Bots and making own story maps for Bee Bot.*

Once Upon a Time - Y2 Modern Tales

Geography

- Use maps, atlases and globes to identify the UK and selected other countries.
- Activities - *maps and flags of the world. Journey across to ocean.*

History

- Significant individuals from the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. Some should be used to compare aspects of life in different periods - Christopher Columbus
- Offers opinions and facts with some reasoning about an historical event.

Activities -

Christopher Columbus and his adventures

What was life like on board the ship.

How was travelling different from today?

Music

- Sing songs creatively adding accompaniments, changing the words and musical qualities.
- Understand how different musical elements combined can create a mood.

Activities - *Harvest songs, music to add to story*

Science

- Plants

Activities - *Investigating growth of seeds and bulbs, investigating what a seed needs to grow.*

Art

- Use a variety of media - Paint (ready mix, powder, block)
- Use simple dyeing techniques including tie dyeing, and printing.

Activities - *Creating a fairy-tale setting, creating a fairground setting and characters. Create a flag for new setting (tie dyeing)*
