

COMMUNICATION AND LITERACY

- Provide opportunities for the children to talk and share ideas/news.
- Enjoy and discuss well known and new stories
- Develop children's language skills through role play, imaginary games & table top activities.
- Continue to send Ben & Freda Bear home with the children and share his experiences as part of the routines each day.
- Rhyming activities - Use games, objects, pictures to match 2 things that rhyme.
- In reading area encourage the children to share and enjoy a variety of books and audio tapes.
- Continue to introduce sounds through the daily L&S session.
- Opportunities for writing throughout the learning zones
- Pencil control activities/formal letter

MATHEMATICS

- Recognise, recite, write and sequence numbers to 10.
- Count out sets of objects to 10
- Number songs & stories
- Sequence patterns / activities
- Understand & explore Day & Night
- Recap use mathematical names for 2D shapes.
- Become familiar with 3D shapes. Notice shapes all around.
- Measurement: understand language heavier, lighter, smaller, bigger
- Birthday cake & candles add 1 more....1 less...

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

- Introduce traditional celebrations-Bonfire night, Christmas, Divali...
- Think about Remembrance day - DVD/story/creative drawings of poppies
- Think about the occasions we celebrate - birthdays, marriage....
- Children to explore objects and materials using the light box
- Children can talk about family traditions-Bonfire, Christmas, birthday celebrations....
- Observations of changes taking place during the Autumn/Winter months.
- ICT: introduce Beebots and programming
- Use ipads & Seesaw - children to record their own learning.
- Exploring 'reflective' materials

- Independence and organising own basic needs - dressing/undressing for PE.
- Using equipment safely.
- Explore colour mixing using coloured water & pippets

- Learn new songs /movements for the Christmas play: Angel Express
